

Shadow Valley Fish Passage Project ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the Shadow Valley Fish Passage project, near the city of Shelton, Mason County, WA, will be received at the offices of the SPSSEG, 6700 Martin Way E, Suite 112, Olympia, WA 98516 or via email at caseya@spsseg.org until **4:00 pm, Wednesday, May 25th, 2026**. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered. Electronic proposals will be in a PDF format and including scanned copies of the original signed non-collusion certificate. Original signed copies must be produced prior to award of Contract.

This contract provides for the construction of the Shadow Valley Fish Passage project in Mason County. This is a culvert replacement project, with strong instream restoration and enhancement element, funded by the BAFBRB (State). The primary project elements include:

- Removal of a timber fishway and culverts and backfilling the restored area
- Installation of 30-foot span by 12-foot-wide bridge and casting of bridge footings
- Construction of side road and grading current road to bridge elevation
- Excavation to create a new 260 foot long channel, installing streambed gravel and cobble, deformable grade controls, large woody debris and gravel augmentation
- Creation temporary access to the site is through private property, up to 1100 feet depending on conditions.

This is a Prevailing Wage project.

There will be a mandatory pre-bid meeting on **May 12th, from 2:00pm. to 3:00pm.** The pre-bid meeting will entail a site walk and review of proposed access routes, channel excavation alignment, LWD placement locations, proposed grubbing, culvert removal and sequencing, and bridge installation and location.
